Owners of property in Milam and Burleson Counties, which comprise the Post Oak Savannah Groundwater Conservation District, who produce groundwater or have the right to produce groundwater are advised that the Board of Directors of the Post Oak Savannah Groundwater Conservation District will host a District Stakeholder Meeting on October 13, 2009, at 5:30 p.m., at the Milano Community and Civic Center located at 120 West Avenue E in Milano, Texas. The Milano Community and Civic Center is located approximately 3 blocks east of the Post Office in downtown Milano.

The Post Oak Savannah Groundwater Conservation District (District) is located in the central part of the area designated by the Texas Water Development Board as Groundwater Management Area 12 (GMA 12). As the resources of groundwater in the area are shared among ten counties in this area of the state, the District, along with the four other groundwater conservation districts (GCDs) that comprise GMA 12 are charged by State law to jointly adopt Desired Future Conditions (DFCs) for the aquifers in this area.

Please note that there will also a District Board of Directors Meeting immediately following this Stakeholder meeting at the same location in Milano, Texas and that this meeting is also open to the public.

The purpose of this Stakeholder meeting is to discuss the following topics with, and receive comments from, stakeholders in the District. The topics to be discussed or considered are as listed below. Items may or may not be taken in the same order as shown on this meeting notice.

2. Public Comment
3. GMA 12 joint planning process and preliminary DFCs, groundwater resources in the District, and future process for evaluating District preliminary DFCs and DFCs, and identification of possible necessary changes to District Rules and District Groundwater Management Plan
4. Stakeholder input to the District on items listed in agenda item 3 above
5. Discussion of projected future conditions of aquifers in the District
6. Adjourn Stakeholder Meeting
