



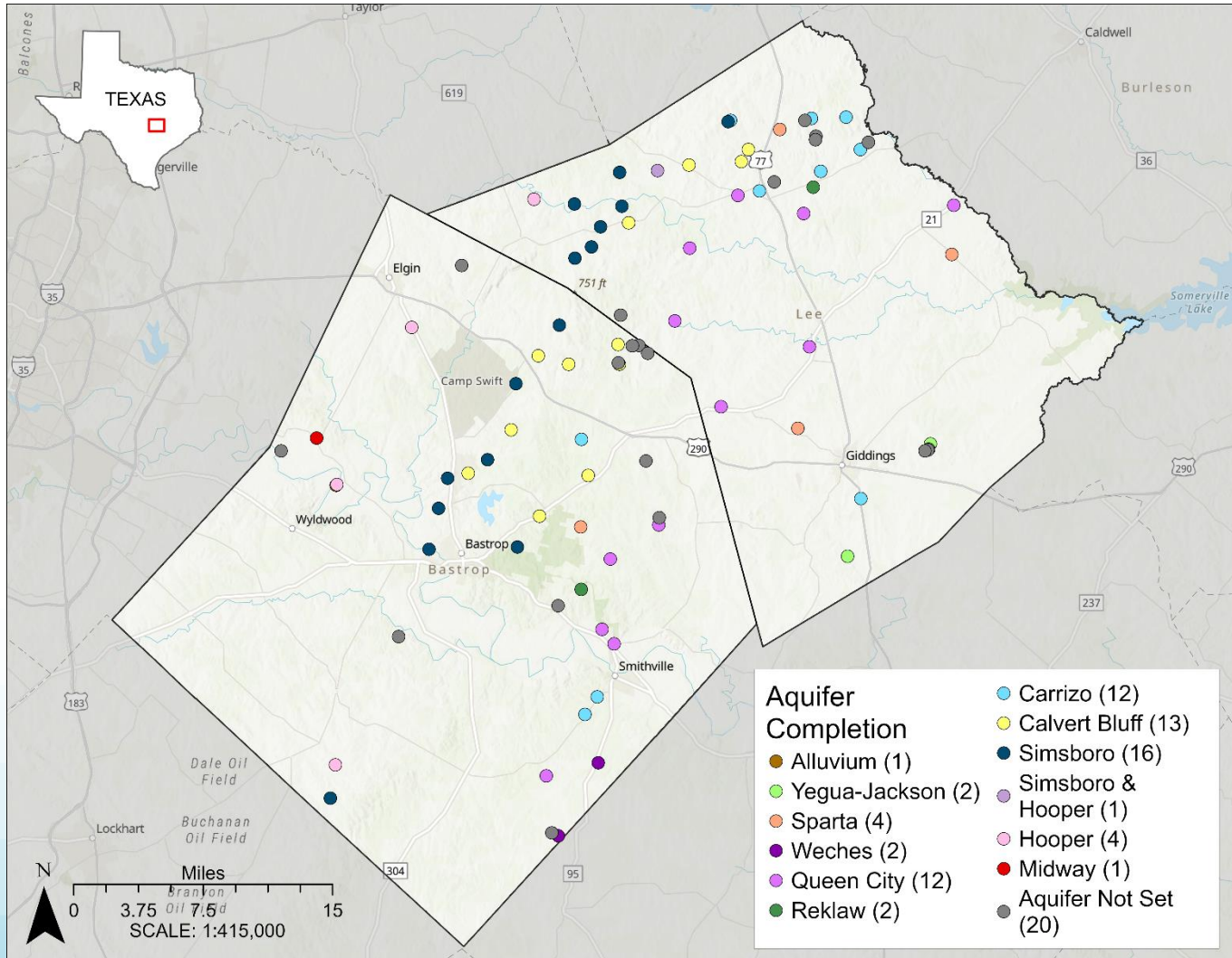

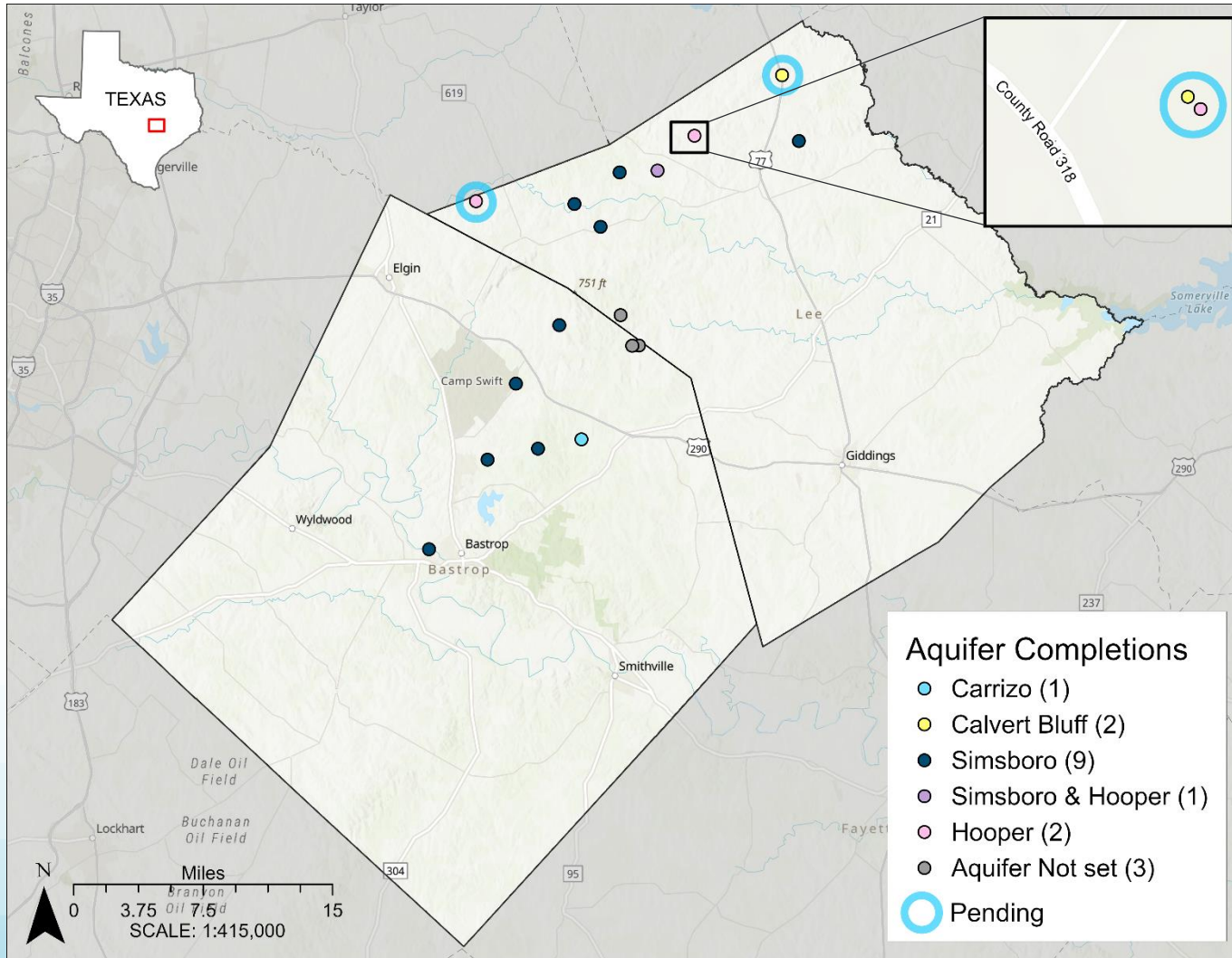

LPGCD MONITORING WELL LOCATIONS



- 11 geologic units represented
- Water levels measured twice a year
 - Oct/Nov
 - Mar/Apr
- Most recently measured this month
 - 91 wells measured

LPGCD CONTINUOUSLY MONITORED WELLS

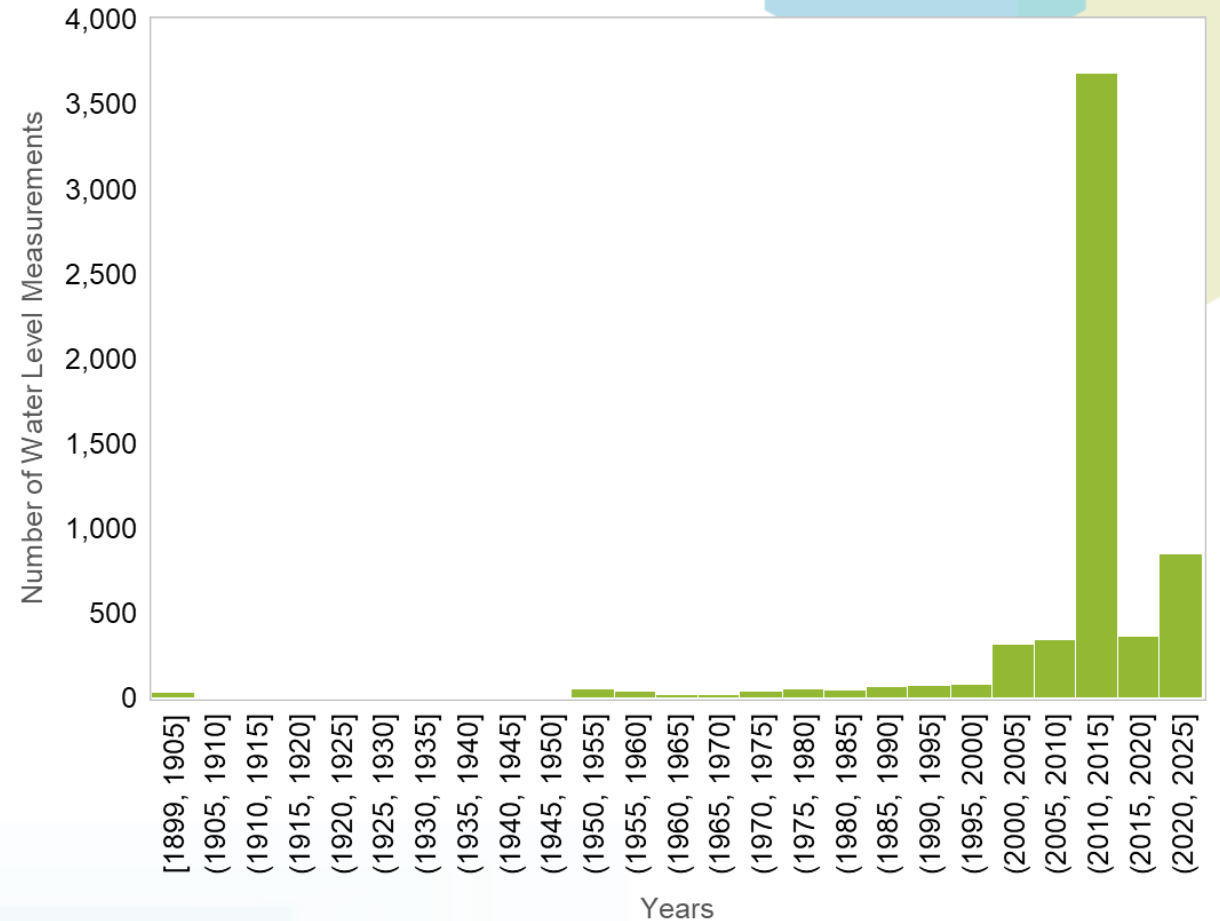


- 18 continuously monitored wells
- 5 aquifers monitored
- Simsboro Aquifer has largest spatial distribution of monitoring wells
- Additional monitoring wells pending:
 - 4 wells identified
 - 5 wells to be identified

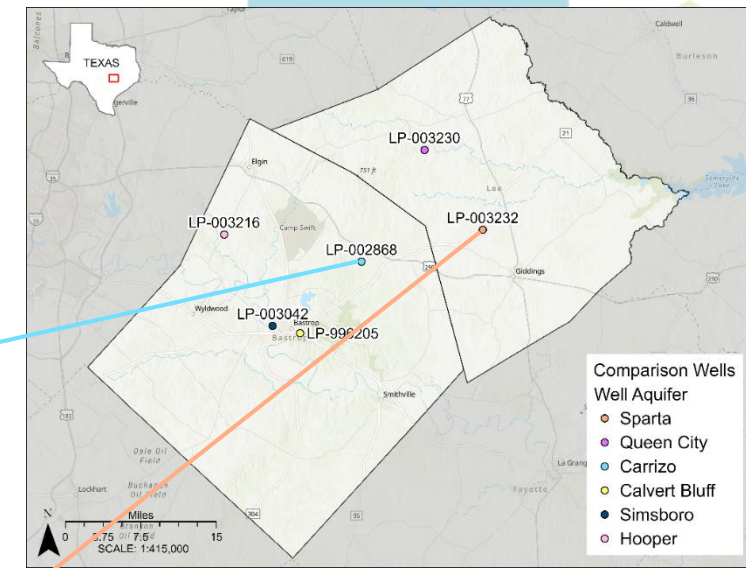
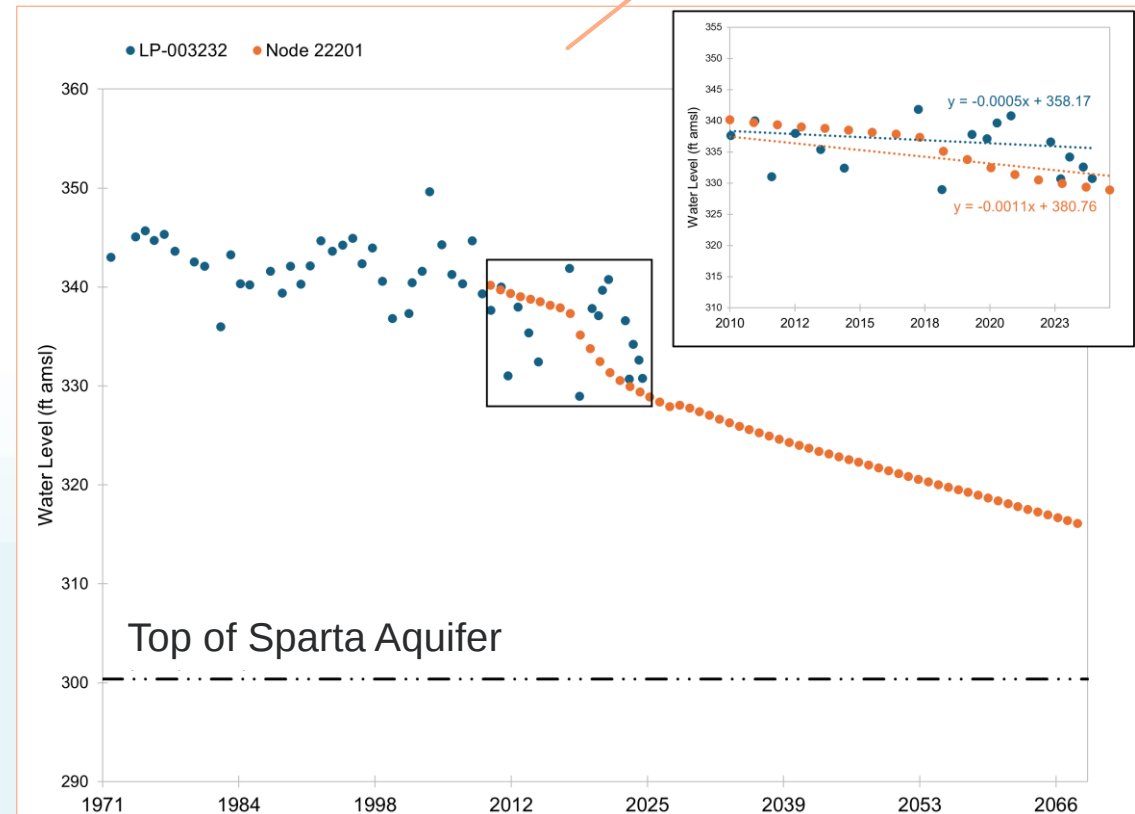
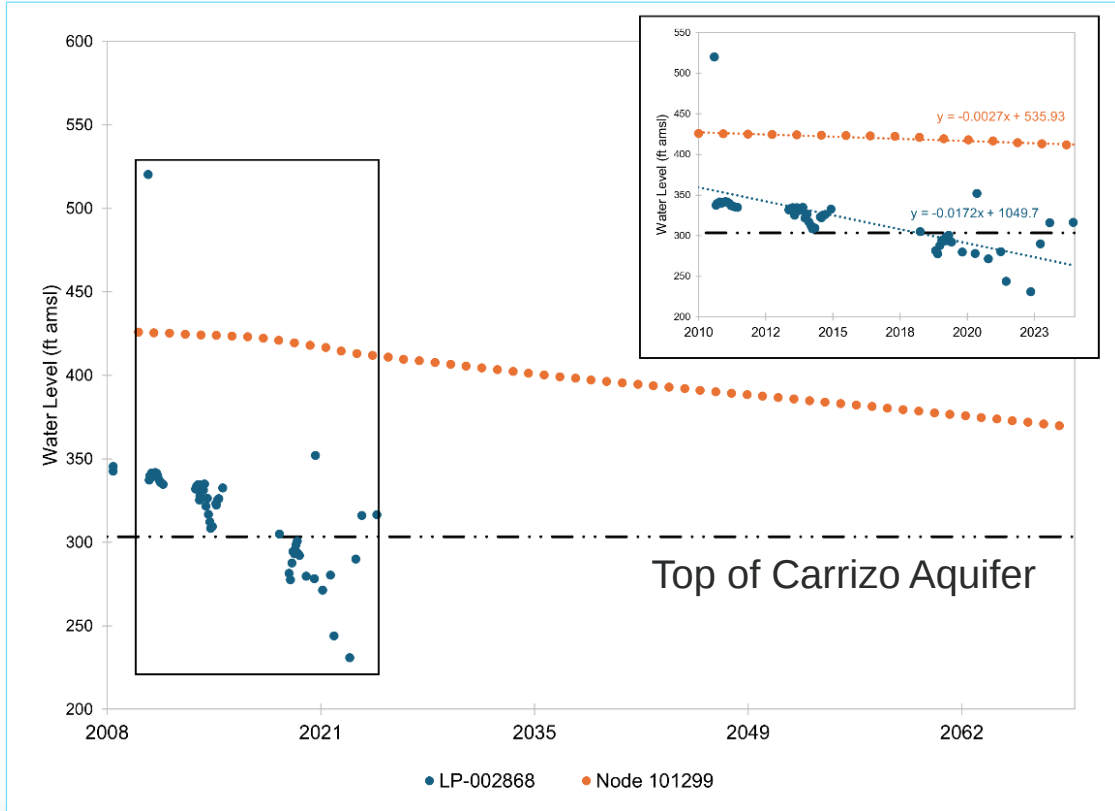
