GMA 12 General Managers,

As a landowner in Lee County with private wells already suffering from Vista Ridge drawdown, I am writing to you ahead of Monday's DFC vote.

Groundwater management should be based on the best available science, not on legal settlements or the administrative ambitions of a single district. Increasing drawdown to accommodate commercial export pumping is unconscionable and effectively codifies the destruction of rural infrastructure.

I urge you to lead GMA 12 in re-adopting the current DFCs and protecting the domestic and livestock well owners who make up the vast majority of our community. Please protect water rights from the deep pockets of commercial water interests that are depleting our water resources for profit. The legacy of our community is at risk.
