Project Updates

Burleson County AgriLife Demonstration Garden

- Staff reviewed several bids and selected Innovative Water Solutions to install the rainwater collection system. There's a 7-10 week wait, and start date is still pending.

Streamline Website Conversion

- Goal of the project was to improve accessibility and navigation of the website, while also putting us in compliance with upcoming enforcement of ADA accessibility requirements going into affect by the Department of Justice April 2027. The Streamline team is still working on converting the significant number of documents we have available to the public, and staff is working with the design team on page designs and organization of pages and tabs. 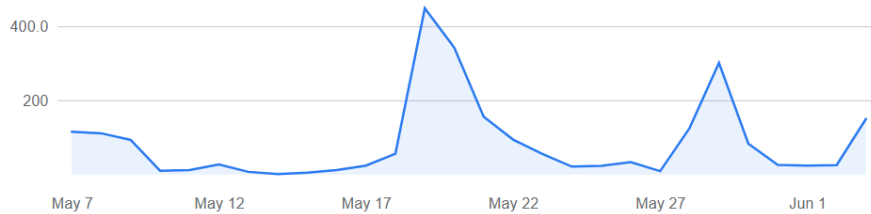

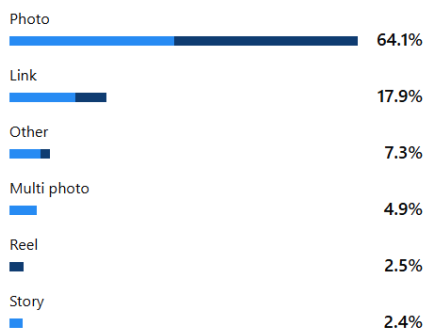


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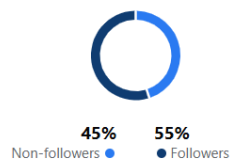
